Payment term options

TUITION AND SUPPLEMENTARY CHARGES

First half due on or before September 1st – second half due on or before January 1st or eight (8) equal instalments from September 1st to April 1st. Interest at the rate of 15% is calculated on the outstanding balance of fees.

ANNUAL RE-REGISTRATION FEE

A registration fee of \$200 is payable before February 28 and credited to the following year's fees.

INSTRUMENT FEE

An annual fee of \$215 dollars is invoiced in October for Cycle 3 (grades 5 & 6) of the elementary school program and for music students in the secondary school in order to cover the rental costs of musical instruments.

ACCESSORY SERVICES

In order to provide an exceptional learning experience to the students, the School provides an agenda, school supplies, textbooks, stationery, workbooks and a yearbook to students. Additionally, the School offers special events, trips, extra curricular and other activities to the students. Also, certain theatre outings, and athletics receive additional financial support in order to enhance said programs. The School provides cutting edge computer science materials and tools in order to ensure the integration of technology in the teaching and learning process. To finance said materials and tools, the parents agree to pay the supplemental fees which partially cover costs for software, laptops, materials, updates, maintenance, interactive white boards and multimedia equipment.

LUNCH PROGRAM

Tasty and nutritious lunches are included in the accessory services fee and are provided to students on a daily basis. Sandwiches, soups, salads or hot meals, and dessert are included in their compulsory lunch program.

OVERNIGHT TRIPS

An additional fee may be invoiced during the year to cover the cost of organized overnight trips.

LANGUAGE SUPPORT FEE

\$10,000 for the first year a new student entering grades 2 to 9 who may require support in French as a second language (FSL). All students are to have English language skills. Students applying for grade 10 & 11 must be fluent in English and French.

AFTER SCHOOL SERVICES

The Study supports its kindergarten to grade 6 families by offering exciting, enriching and bilingual After School services which balance homework assistance and creative activities. The Extended Day & Homework Supervision Programme allows students to enjoy playtime activities and homework time under the supervision of bilingual animators.

BUS SERVICE
