The Study's Scholarship & Bursary Programme

Grade 7 | The Study School Foundation Merit Entrance Scholarship

(Full scholarship & renewable for five years)

A full scholarship is to be awarded to the top new student entering Grade 7 for the 2017-18 school year and is based on current school reports, a personal letter of intent, an application and results of the C.A.T. exam. The value of the full scholarship will be applied against school fees each year until the student graduates, provided that she continues to achieve proficiency standing and actively participates in school life.

Application Requirements

Candidates must submit a personal letter indicating their intent to apply for this prestigious scholarship, including:

- why she is applying
- what this scholarship would mean to her, should she be the recipient
- an outline of the goals and ideas on how they intend to be an active member of The Study community

The deadline for receipt of this letter and the application is October 7, 2016. Please submit to:

All candidates will be invited for an interview. The recipient of this scholarship will be notified in writing on November 4, 2016.

Entrance Scholarship

(up to \$5,000 & renewable for three years)

Awarded annually to new incoming Grade 7 students on the basis of overall academic excellence and potential to contribute to school life.

Trillium Scholarship

(\$1,000 & renewable for one year)

This scholarship is awarded to a current Grade 9 student entering Grade 10 and is awarded on the basis of academic merit and a personal interview.

Board of Governors' Scholarship

(\$1,000 & renewable for three years)

This scholarship is awarded to a current Grade 6 student entering the Senior School and is based on an essay (written in either English or French) and personal interview.

Margaret Gascoigne Scholarship

(\$1,000 & renewable for five years)

Named after the school's founder, this scholarship is awarded to a top new incoming Grade 7 student on the basis of C.A.T. scores and a personal interview.

Marcelle Gaudion Scholarship

(\$1,000 & renewable for five or six years)

Awarded to a current student in Grade 4 or 5, based on a French essay and a personal interview.

Bursaries

Bursaries reflect the school's commitment to financially assisting families of students who would benefit from and contribute to The Study experience. The decision to award a bursary is based on a family's demonstrated financial need, as determined by a third-party assessment.
