



The Study's Trillium Tribute Wall Program

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is a Trillium Tribute Emblem?

A Trillium Tribute Emblem (Trillium) is an engraved 8 inch three-petaled trillium, an artistic feature of The Study's Tribute Wall. This new **Dare to Dream Campaign** initiative will allow you to leave a profound and tangible mark within The Study's history by contributing to a beautifully engraved brushed-metal and porcelain Trillium emblem that will be prominently displayed on the wall of the main stairwell.

Q: Are my payments towards the Trillium Emblem eligible for a tax receipt?

Yes, all charitable gifts to **The Study School Foundation** receive an official donation receipt for income tax purposes. Your payments will be attributed to our Greatest Needs Fund (Head's Initiatives) and towards The Study's General Endowment Fund, all in support of the Dare to Dream Campaign.

Q: How much do I need to donate to be able to obtain a Trillium Emblem?

\$5,000 is the minimum donation required to dedicate a Trillium Tribute Emblem for display on The Study's Trillium Tribute wall. The gift payment may be made in full or pledged to be paid over a maximum of five years. For example, if you pledge your \$5,000 gift over five years, it is \$1,000 a year for five years. We are happy to work with you to structure your gift to suit your preferences – should it be yearly, quarterly or monthly payments. You may, however, pay off your pledge in full at any time.

Q: I am a Study parent. If I buy a Trillium, will it count towards 2018 Give Week Participation?

Yes, if you reserve your Trillium during **Give Week** itself (April 30 to May 4, 2018) your reservation payment will also count towards your participation in the Give Week Campaign! Furthermore, if your reservation payment is among our first 100 Give week gifts, it will contribute to raising an additional \$150 for the school from our Give Week matching gift donors.

Q: How many petals may be inscribed?

You may use up to three petals to honour one or more individuals.

Q: Is there a character limit per petal on my Trillium?

Yes, the maximum character length is 30 characters including spaces (no titles please).

Q: Are there restrictions on the names we can inscribe on the Trillium?

Any name or names can be inscribed on your Trillium provided that they do not exceed 30 characters per petal (including spaces)*. The petals may be inscribed with the name of someone being honoured or remembered or the donor may include their own name on the emblem.

- Eg. 1 Claire Smith '88 & John Brown (29 characters)
- Eg. 2 The Brown Family (16 characters)
- Eg. 3 John Brown (10 characters)
- Eg. 4 Mary Smith-Brown '20 (20 characters)

**No naming will be accepted if such naming will call into question the integrity or reputation of The Study.*

Q: When does the Trillium Wall Program end?

This program will end on June 29, 2018 or until all Trilliums have been reserved.

Q: Where will the Trilliums be displayed?

The Trilliums will be prominently displayed on the wall of the main stairwell.

Q: May I select where my Trillium will be displayed?

No. Since this is an art installation, the arrangement of Trilliums on the wall will be respectfully done in a manner that befits the intent of a Tribute Wall.

Q: Is the Trillium Tribute Wall considered a Donor Wall?

No, although donors may recognize themselves by having their own name inscribed on one of the three petals of their Trillium.

Q: When will the Trillium Emblems be installed?

Your Trillium will be installed over the summer of 2018.
